Additional Sermon Notes:

### Why do we worship?

We worship God because he is so wonderful and because he deserves the worship of our hearts.

### What is worship?

Worship is all our attention focused on God. Worship happens when what I think, say, and do is all about Jesus. Worship can happen anytime, anywhere, and in many ways. In our worship service we speak words of worship, sing, pray and listen to teaching from God's Word.

### How do we worship?

The **Call to Worship** is the opening part of the service. God calls us to gather before him and praise his name.

### What are some words in the Call to Worship that describe God?

Next is the **Confession of Sin**. We recite corporately (all together as a church) a prayer of confession and have a time of silently confessing our own sins.

### What are some words in the Confession that show what we are asking forgiveness for?

After the **Confession** we have the **Assurance of Grace**. As we read some verses from the Bible, God reminds us that he forgives us when we confess our sins.

**What are some words or phrases in the verses that show the love and forgiveness God gives us?**

The next part of the worship service is **Affirming Our Faith**. This is where we speak out loud what we believe and know to be true about God.

**What are some words or phrases that tell you what we believe about God, Jesus, the Gospel, or Scripture?**

We now come to the part of the service where we read God's Word and hear the pastor speak to us from it.
